PUTTING TOGETHER **FIRST STEP** HYGIENE KITS

WHAT YOU'LL NEED FOR EACH KIT:

- 2-IN-1 SHAMPOO /CONDITIONER**
- RAZOR**
- WASHCLOTH**
- SCRIPTURE CARD**
- BAR SOAP**
- COMB**
- SHAVE CREAM**
- DEODORANT (MEN'S/WOMEN'S)**
- TOOTHPASTE**
- TOOTHBRUSH**

ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES:

- Hand Sanitizer- (not included) every volunteer must use hand sanitizer before making kits, applied once.
- Clear Bags- to place hygiene items in. (press air out of bag before tying)
- Black Contractor Bags- Place completed kits in bag in increments of 50.
- TBM Sticker- Place TBM sticker on contractor bag.

KITS IN **10** EASY STEPS:

- 1** Line up 3-4 tables longways and side by side on the short ends.
- 2** Fold all washcloths before assembling kits. (We suggest making the washcloth the first item to go into the kit)
- 3** Place items in stacks/bins in the center of the tables to form an assembly line of kit items.
- 4** The hand sanitizer and clear bags need to be first on the table. The black contractor bags and stickers will need to be at the end of the tables. Washcloths should be set up to be the first item to go into the kit.
- 5** You will need one volunteer to ensure every person uses hand sanitizer before assembling kits.
- 6** Each volunteer will complete one bag at a time to ensure every item is provided in each kit. **DO NOT** pass bag from one person to another to fill. Many times, there are missing items when this project is rushed and families do not receive all items. Each volunteer is responsible to start and finish their kit.
- 7** Once all of the items have been added to the clear bag, press the air out of the bag and tie.
- 8** A volunteer is needed to count the kits as they are completed. They will bag 50 kits per contractor bag. Place a TBM sticker on the bag. Press air out and tie.
- 9** Once someone has completed a kit they can return to the line to complete another, until all kits are completed.
- 10** Please consider praying over all hygiene kits once they have been completed. There will be some additional items left over. Please do not make kits if you do not have enough items to complete a full kit. Once an item runs out, please stop making kits.
